W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. considers employees, clients and other direct and indirect stakeholders in the company as stakeholders. In all its activities, W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. the stakeholders.

As a guideline for the corporate social responsibility that W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. it uses the ISO 26000 guideline. The 7 principles of ISO 26000 have been implemented at W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. and are part of the decision-making process.

For the environment, W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. is committed to spreading the message of the need to protect and/or improve the living environment and may also support stakeholders in realising improvement processes, with respect for land, forest and water rights and forced eviction.

W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. is active in the environmental field where it is not only about CO₂ emissions. Steps have already been taken with regard to lighting in the offices, the further promotion of double-sided printing and the more and more digital files.

W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. provides guidelines on how Employees should be approached in the decision-making process so that this is in line with the mission and values of W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. This, in turn, promotes the requirement to perform tasks in a way that promotes honesty and integrity, meets professional standards in the field, to address challenges without bias, fosters self-awareness among its Employees so that they have the building blocks to make ethical decisions.

W. van den Brink International Transport B.V. strives for good control of the effects on the areas of quality, private and public safety, health, environment and security by the actions of its organization. To this end,

the internal processes, such as the quality management system ISO 9001 and ISO 14001, will be audited by third parties.
